[Case V-19-2022](#), 1221 Fairmont Avenue, TMS#5320200031.** Request for relief from the strict application of §156.119(G)(2) to allow utilization of a Telecommunications Carrier on Wheels (COW) for a period not to exceed 120 days. This is an extension of a relocation of the 100-foot-tall COW ballast pole located at 520 King Street which has been replaced with two 60-foot-tall Cell on Light Truck (COLTS). The ordinance limits the use of COWs for a period not to exceed 120 days following a natural disaster or local emergency declaration.
