He said it is not being used for anything other than communications equipment and there are things that the Town can do to work with Mount Pleasant Waterworks to have a park as part of the neighborhood, possibly using part of the water tower. He said he would like to make sure a park is built and to potentially name it after Walter and Lois Brown who have been advocates in keeping the water tower.
