RESIDENTIAL MEDICAL WASTE DISPOSAL

Must be disposed of in a manner that helps minimize health risks to waste management and landfill workers. Sharp medical objects must be placed in a medical/health care container with a tight-fitting lid and "Non-recyclable" written on it. Do not use glass containers.

PROPER DISPOSAL OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS DO NOT FLUSH prescription drugs down the toilet. Instead, take them to a drug take-back location.



COMPACT FLOURESCENT LIGHTBULB DISPOSAL

Take all unbroken bulbs to a big box home improvement store where they will be properly recycled.



Guidelines for your trash piles...

COLLECTIBLE ITEMS

Yard Debris - leaves/grass clippings in brown paper bags, brush, tree limbs



Appliances and metal items



Furniture, and other non-food items that you are unable to donate or recycle



E-waste - These items must be placed separately at the curb for special collection/recycling. Residents for proper disposal.
