Park West Lake Pavilion

Ages 10 – 13

Cost - \$180 resident/ \$210 non-resident - includes a \$50 non-refundable, non-transferable deposit.

All admission fees on field trips are covered (does not include any extras). Campers may bring extra money and will be totally responsible for it and may only spend it as approved each day by the camp director.

Hours- 9:00 a.m.- 5:00 p.m.

An adult must come into the Lake Pavilion to sign in and sign out each participant each day. Early drop-off is available from 8:30 a.m.- 9:00 a.m. and late pick-up until 5:30 p.m. Drop-off and pick-up are at the Lake Pavilion Building in the MPRD Park West Complex. The Lake Pavilion is located on the OPPOSITE side of the MPRD complex from the swimming pool, program building and tennis courts.

Swimming- We will swim at the MPRD Park West indoor pool **on days that our field trip schedule permits.**

Please be prepared each day to swim.

Bus – Each day, the Pre-Teen Travel Camp will board a bus and depart on various trips throughout the Lowcountry.

***Your child will need to bring their lunch, water and backpack with them on the bus daily.**

Don't Miss the Bus- Please make sure your child is on time for camp each day. The Recreation Department will not be responsible if your child misses the bus. **We depart daily as early as 9:30 a.m.** and return by 4:00 p.m.

Personal items - Campers are responsible for all personal items brought to camp (including electronics) and may use them only at the discretion of the Camp Director.

Please notify camp director of any special needs or food allergies.

Bring:

Please pack **lunch** in insulated lunch bag with ice pack and a **drink** daily.

Please wear **tennis shoes** and **socks** to camp **daily**. (Pack flip-flops or crocs for possible swimming.)

Please pack **water bottle** daily in addition to lunch drink.

Please have your child bring a **backpack with bathing suit, towel, goggles and lunch every day.**

Medications, including epi-pens, must be given to camp director when checking in each day.

Please apply **sunscreen** to your child before camp (please pack extra).

Campers should wear appropriate clothing.
