

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has received a subgrant application for funding through the Port Security Grant Program. Pursuant to Executive Order 11988 and 44 CFR Part 9.12, public notice is hereby given of FEMA's intent to provide funding for this project under the Port Security Grants Program. This notice serves as a project- specific public notice for FEMA's funding action located within a Special Flood Hazard Area. FEMA has determined that the only practicable alternative is to fund the security enhancements, already located within the Special Flood Hazard Area. Funding for the proposed project will be conditional upon compliance with all applicable federal, tribal, state and local laws, regulations, floodplain standards, permit requirements and conditions. This action complies with the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) requirements

Proposed Work/Purpose: Purchase and installation of a floating dock enabling the 29" Safeboat to be able to drive up on and keep out of the water when not in use. The dock will be install onto the existing dock

Project Alternatives: The following alternatives were considered:

(1) Relocation of the facilities outside the floodplain – There are no practicable alternatives to locating the proposed actions outside the floodplain. The dock is for storage of vessels for harbor patrol and are of functional dependent use of the location and cannot be place anywhere else.

(2) No action alternative – This alternative is not feasible as the upgrades are necessary to ensure proper and effect monitoring of water ways and accuracy of surveillance. With the no action alternative, negative impact could result in crews not being able to carry put essential functions and mission properly because of not having proper equipment.
