

Billy Swails Boulevard Phase 4B

The South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT), in coordination with the Town of Mount Pleasant, proposes to extend a roadway with an associated multiuse path to support increasing vehicular, bicycle and pedestrian use. This would connect the intersection of Six Mile Road and Sweetgrass Basket Parkway to the intersection of Hamlin Road and the existing Billy Swails Boulevard. The proposed roadway would have one vehicle lane on each side of a separated, variable median. To the north of the vehicle lanes there would be a paved multiuse path to accommodate bicyclists and pedestrians.

The purpose of the project is to add capacity in the north and south travel corridor formed by US Highway 17, the parallel Hungryneck Boulevard/Sweetgrass Basket Parkway/Billy Swails Boulevard, and Rifle Range Road to accommodate increasing vehicle, pedestrian, and bicycle traffic.
